It is compulsory for all students to wear appropriate Dixons Broadgreen Academy uniform. Full and correct uniform is expected at all times and should be worn in an appropriate manner.

# Key Stage 3 (Year 7, 8, 9)

## Core items:

- DBA Logo embroidered school blazer
- Copper school tie (clip on or traditional)
- White shirt with collar
- Black trousers, loose fit skirt or pinafore
- A4 lever arch file size bag / backpack
- Black professional school shoes
- Black socks or plain black tights

## Optional items:

- DBA Jumper grey or black options
- Black or grey hijab (if worn)



# Key Stage 4 (Year 10 and 11)

## Core items:

- **Grey, navy blue or black suit**, either:
  - a jacket and matching trousers or
  - a jacket and matching loose fit skirt or pinafore
- **A tie**, from a choice of 4 colours (clip on or traditional)
  - students can choose to not wear a tie, if wearing a blouse
- **White shirt or blouse**
  - a blouse is an open collar option not requiring a tie
- **A4 lever arch file size bag / backpack**
- **Black professional shoes**
- **Black socks or plain tights** - to match the suit being worn

## Optional items:

- **V neck jumper:**
  - black, grey or navy blue to match suit
  - can be purchased anywhere
- **Black, grey or navy hijab** - to match suit (if worn)





## PE kit

All PE kit should be purchased from our designated suppliers. Alternative styles are not permitted.

### Core Items:

- **Vortex polo**  
- gunmetal / silver / white / silver  
- code: VP8
- **Vortex skort**  
- gunmetal / silver / white / silver  
- code: VSC
- **Vortex shorts**  
- gunmetal / silver / white / silver  
- code: VSH
- **Core socks**  
- gunmetal / silver / white / silver  
- code: ACS



### Optional items:

- Black base layers (top and / or leggings)
- DBA tracksuit

**Blazers must be worn on PE days**

# Core item - expectations of appearance

## White shirts:

- all shirts must be white and have a top button
- apart from blouses, all shirts must have a formal collar.
- the top button must be done up and the tie fastened at the top button
- shirts should be tucked into trousers or skirts

## Black trousers or knee length skirts

- trousers: all black trousers are expected to be:
  - full length
  - tailored or classic boot cut (boys)
  - tailored or loose legged (girls)
- skirts – all skirts are expected to be:
  - plain
  - no shorter than knee length
  - loose fit or pinafore
- plain black belts may be worn through belt loops in trousers / skirts

## The following items are not allowed:

- jeans, trousers with rivets, jean style pockets or accessory zips
- leggings or skinny / tight fit trousers
- tracksuit bottoms or shorts

# Core item - expectations of appearance

## Shoes:

- all school shoes must be all black, flat, polishable and formal in style
- all school shoes must provide adequate support and protection

## School shoes must NOT be any of the following or in the style of any of the following:

- trainers\*, skate shoes, canvas shoes or logos
- high heels
- boots of any kind
- \*parents / carers should note that some shoe shops include black 'trainer style' shoes in their school shoe section. These will not be appropriate.

# Core item - expectations of appearance

## School bag:

- all school bags must be large enough to hold an A4 folder and all appropriate equipment. This includes:
  - A4 Morning Meeting pack
  - pencil case with a full stationary set
  - planner
  - any other appropriate items a student may wish to bring to school e.g. a pair of trainers to play football in during social time
- **A backpack is strongly recommended**
- Any bag which is too small to contain the above items is not allowed
- School bags **must be brought to school every day**

# Expectations of appearance

## Hair:

- hair must be one natural colour throughout
- hair must be in an appropriate style for a professional environment:
  - shaved pattern cuts are not allowed
  - grade 1 or lower all over cuts are not allowed
- the view of what hair styles, colours and accessories are appropriate, excessive or discrete is at the discretion of the school. We encourage all families to check with their child's Head of Year prior to making a choice

## Jewellery:

- KS3 are not to wear jewellery of any kind
- KS4 and KS5 - students may wear metal stud earrings (one in each lower lobe)
- no other jewellery is permitted. This includes the following:
  - all other kind of earrings (including stretch earrings or spikes)
  - bracelets or necklaces
  - other body piercings, such as nose, upper ear, eyebrow or tongue (including plastic fill ins)
  - plasters may not be worn to cover any of the above

## Make-up:

- no make-up is to be worn in school
- false eye lashes, nail polish and acrylic / gel nails are not permitted in school and will need to be removed

## Coats:

- an outdoor coat is recommended
- coats or jackets must not be worn in the school building
- no non-Dixons Broadgreen Academy items of clothing should be worn underneath the blazer as a substitute for a coat





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
