

## Homework – Year 11 Cycle 2

We know that students need to be familiar with the style in which exam questions are written in order to reduce cognitive overload and that they need to know how marks are awarded by exam boards in order to maximise their grades.

  - Full name and Advisory group need to be written at the top of the page
  - We would expect the revision notes to show an efficient use of the A4 paper, using standard font size that would be acceptable in an exam
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
