# **Attendance**

In secondary school, 19 days' absence throughout the school year correlates, on average, to a grade at GCSE in all subjects. 97% attendance is the Academy's expectation, but we are striving for 100% every day. Students under 90% are classed as persistent absentees by the Government and, if all attempts to improve attendance has failed, the case will be sent to the Local Education Authority. They will then investigate the case and potentially prosecute parents for non- attendance at school; this can involve large fines. It is ultimately the parents' responsibility to ensure their child attends school.

## Changes to the school day - Academic Year 2023 - 24

There is change to the finish time of the school day in the academic year 2023 - 24. Monday - Thursday lessons will finish at 3:20. This is to incorporate Personal Development Studies and Careers into a fixed slot on a Thursday p1. We are excited about the opportunity to book visiting speakers and events for our students.

The DEAR (Drop Everything and Read) Session will be moved to the advisory slot at lunch time where that year group is not on lunch break. This will give us the opportunity to deliver more focused intervention sessions.
