Changes to Uniform on PE Days

Attendance

In secondary school, 19 days' absence throughout the school year correlates, on average, to a grade at GCSE in all subjects. 97% attendance is the Academy's expectation, but we are striving for 100% every day. Students under 90% are classed as persistent absentees by the Government and, if all attempts to improve attendance has failed, the case will be sent to the Local Education Authority. They will then investigate the case and potentially prosecute parents for non- attendance at school; this can involve large fines. It is ultimately the parents' responsibility to ensure their child attends school.

Y11 Tutoring English and Maths

If your child is in receipt of additional tutoring for English and Maths outside the school day please ensure that they are online promptly to start the session.

Visit from our CEO Luke Sparkes

Luke Sparkes visited DBA this week to do a tour and student voice. The students were asked what they liked about school, they said the following:

The environment is calmer, clearer with a lot less disruption; their teachers want what is best for them; they are better supported; they keep getting better; natural state in corridors helps them a lot due to the split school day; Look cover write check helps them with morning meeting; improved grades and that school is better now.

When asked what they wanted to improve about school, they said the following:

They would like revision booklets for all subjects; the toilets need to be opened earlier so that they are not waiting at break and lunch; PE classes should be mixed (for some sports); corrections should be given for non-completion of Educake and that they would like more dining space.
