Information for Parents

Spending a day at Dixons Broadgreen Academy will help prepare your child for the move to secondary school in September 2025.

Pupils should arrive at school from 8.50am ready for a 9am start. **They should wear their normal primary school uniform.**

We will start the day with an assembly in the school hall and then pupils will follow a timetable of secondary school lessons, including PE. Please note pupils can wear PE pumps/ trainers for their afternoon session.

All pupils will receive lunch, free of charge.

At 2.20pm, pupils will be dismissed and will exit the school gates on Heliers Road. Please make your own arrangements for your children to be collected.

Heliers Road is very busy and there is **no parking available on this road or in the school**. If you are coming by car, **please park away from school and walk to the school site**.

Dear Families,

Did you know ... just registering your child for Free School Meals means that our academy gets extra money to spend on our students?

Register now to make sure we don't miss out

The Government gives money to schools and academies to help children from families with lower incomes to do their very best. This funding is called a 'Pupil Premium'.

For every child registered, Dixons Broadgreen Academy will get £1,050 into our budget for the year 2025/2026 to spend on our students

How does it work?

1. First, check if you qualify – it is not just if you are unemployed, so please look at the list on the next page
2. Registering is really quick and easy – if you think you qualify, contact Liverpool City Council for advice or apply online at <https://liverpool.gov.uk/benefits/free-school-meals>
3. If you want your child to have a free, healthy meal at lunchtime that's great – they will get the free meal (saving you approximately £400 a year), extra benefits and the academy gets £1,050 extra.
4. If you don't want your child to have the academy meals they can continue as normal – as long as you qualify and are registered, the academy still gets £1,050 extra.

If you qualify, please register now to make sure your child and others in their class don't miss out.

If you live outside of Liverpool in either Sefton or Knowsley please apply via the websites on the next page



Do you qualify?

If you or your partner receive any of the following benefits you can apply.

- Universal Credit - your household earned annual income must be less than £7,400 after tax and not including any benefits
- Income Support
- Income based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income related Employment Support Allowance
- Support under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed part of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit – with no Working Tax Credit and your annual household income is no more than £16,190, as assessed by the Inland Revenue

You must be the named recipient of the benefit to make the free school meals application
