**Online Appointment Booking**

In order to keep families and our staff safe and well, we are continuing to use School Cloud for Parents Evenings this year. School Cloud is an online appointment booking system which allows you to choose your own appointment with teachers at a time within the two-hour period that is suitable for you. You will be able to book five-minute slots with your child's teachers using School Cloud. Time slots will be allocated on a first come, first served basis, however you will be able to see the next available appointment with the teacher. You will receive an email confirming your appointment times from School Cloud.

Appointments can be made from Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> February, 6pm and will close on Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> February 2022 at 9pm. Should you wish to make any changes after this date please contact the school office and leave a message for Miss P Jones.
